How do we design cabinets for your home?

The short answer is that we can only do this through good communication with you. We have an experienced staff of designers as well as an architect who understands people and design. We have a combined 60 years experience and have designed and delivered hundreds of kitchens nationwide.

The first step is to call Holly Butler, AIA at 641-323-6105 9-1 PM CST. She will walk you through the process and answer any questions you might have. Below are some typical questions and answers that will help get you started.

What do you charge for design?

We will create one free CAD drawing and modify it up to 2 more times at no charge. After that, any changes to the drawings will be charged at an hourly rate. The design process can take 2-3 weeks or longer depending upon how quickly you need cabinets or how slowly you want to explore every option. Most cabinets require apx.12 weeks for construction plus 2 weeks for delivery. Lead times may vary depending on the time of year and supply chain or logistical factors.

- State-of-the-art soft-close drawers and hinges by Blum and Hettich, recognized European brands with a lifetime warranty
- Efficient Ambialine drawer organization by Blum


What colors are available?

Can I get samples of the colors and the cabinets?

Samples of our paint colors are available in a fan deck format. A sample cabinet box is also available to get a sense of how substantial these cabinets are fabricated. Both samples can be shipped to you for a two week period and then they must be returned to us. Call Holly to order samples 641-323-6105.

How does shipping work?

We can ship your cabinets anywhere to the contiguous United States (48 states) via a common carrier. The final mile will be shipped via a white glove service which will deliver on a smaller truck directly into your home. Some restrictions apply.

What about installation?

We recommend that you locate a reputable professional finish carpenter to do the measuring and installation of your cabinets. We will work closely with them to make sure they have everything they need to complete the job as designed.









What are the steps in designing and ordering?

- 1. You will send us a sketch of your desired layout or your existing kitchen, bathroom, bar, patio cook space, laundry room, etc.
- 2. Please also send us pictures from magazines, Pinterest, or Houzz of kitchens, bathrooms, entertainment centers, etc. that you love. The more details you can provide about your desires, the better we can fulfill them.
- 3. We will discuss functionality, accessories, aging in place, special needs, and budget.
- 4. We will create a preliminary CAD drawing at no charge with floor plans and elevations.
- 5. We will send the preliminary design to you for feedback and tweak the plans up to two more times at no charge.
- 6. We will price out cabinets including shipping, then tweak the plan again if needed to meet your budget.
- 7. Once the design, plan, and cabinet estimate are approved by you, we will require a 50% deposit via check or bank wire.
- 8. We will order the cabinets We will send the final working drawings for your construction team.
- 9. Receiving and installation of your new cabinets. Final payment will be due upon cabinet delivery.

What is the warranty on these cabinets?

We offer a lifetime warranty on the structural integrity of your cabinetry. This includes the structure of the doors, drawers, and the box. The hardware and the finish are warranted for 25 years.


